A new program being offered at Prince William Sound Community College, beginning in February is the Professional Millwright program. The skills required of a Millwright combine multiple trades like welding, pipefitting, machining, carpentry, and mechanics.

The program at PWSCC is crafted as the gateway for students to become fully qualified millwrights working in the many industries that require this trade skill in Alaska.

Qualified Alaska high schools, working in cooperation with PWSCC Millwright Training Center of Excellence, can offer the first two levels of millwright training to their students in TechPrep classes. PWSCC offers college credit and NCCER certification to successful students in these programs. Time spent in the TechPrep classes counts toward the many hours needed to complete a millwright apprenticeship.
