Prince William Sound Community College is Large Enough to Serve You and Small Enough to Care

HAZWOPER (8, 24 and 40 Hour Programs)

Initial and refresher HAZWOPER courses designed to meet the requirements of 29 CFR 1910.120 for emergency response to hazardous substance releases and hazardous waste site workers.

Confined Space Awareness

Required training for supervisors, attendants and entrants to comply with Federal Confined Space Entry Regulations of 29 CFR 1910.146.

Red Cross First-Aid and CPR with AED

Participants in this course learn to recognize and respond to emergencies including shock, cardiac and breathing emergencies for adults, children and infants, heat and cold emergencies, sudden illnesses and poisonings. Additionally, students will learn first aid for everything from cuts and scrapes to muscles.

NSTC Unescorted Program

The North Slope Training Cooperative (NSTC) is a combined effort of BP, ConocoPhillips, Alyeska Pipeline and their contractors. Training provides health, safety and environmental awareness training. Every employee on the north slope is required to complete the program before arrival on the North Slope.

Alaska Host Customer Service Training

Alaska Host is a statewide customer service training program designed for employees of the hospitality and visitor services industry. The core of the Alaska Host program trains participants in how to provide quality customer service for both residents and visitors to Alaska.

USCG Operator Uninspected Passenger Vessel (OUPV)

Course teaches topics such as weather, first aid, seamanship, pollution control, navigation, and rules of the road that are necessary to pass the USCG examination to operate a marine vessel for hire.

Training to Meet Your Needs

Specially designed courses meeting regulatory and industry standards are offered in safety, oil spill response and information technology.

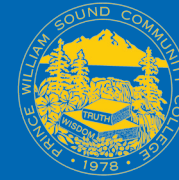
Delivery options include independent study, on-site delivery of specialized industry classes, on-line courses, and traditional classroom settings.
